Operating the Keurig

1. Check the water reservoir at the back is full
2. Open front top compartment
3. Insert new Keurig pod
4. Close front top compartment.
5. Press the desired ounces of coffee (6, 8, or 10).

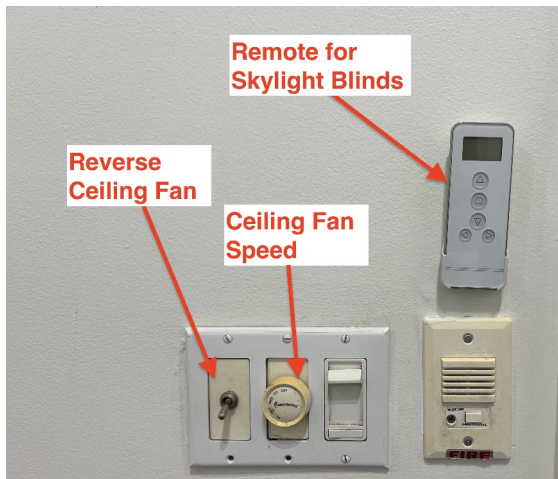
Mail

The small key opens the mailbox at the building entrance. Leave any mail that does not belong to you. We will send someone periodically to pickup mail that belongs to the owner or previous guests.

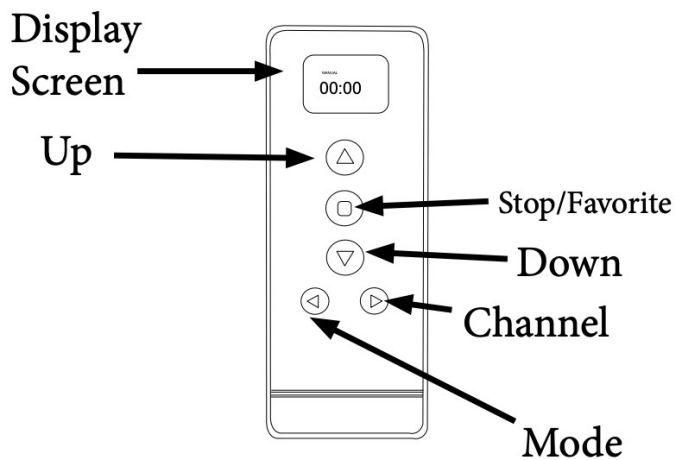
The Dryer

If you find your clothes are still slightly damp, please check the lint tray has been cleaned and use the “Timed Dry” setting. The dryer has a moisture sensor and depending on the size and type of load you are drying the sensor might be a bit off, but the Timed Dry setting will work

It is best not to press the Mode or Channel buttons.

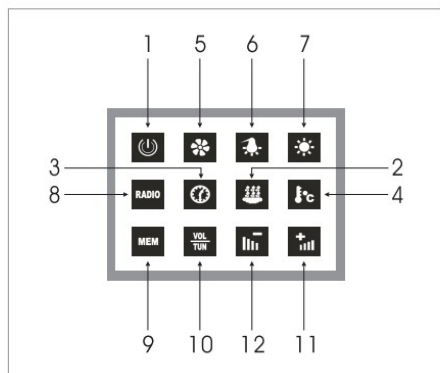
Troubleshooting the Remote

If the blinds are giving you problems, please make sure the blinds are set to Manual Mode and Channel 1.

Operating the Steam Shower

Please leave the shower door open or slightly ajar after you're done so it can air out and prevent mildew.

F8 Control panel keys and operating instructions



1).Power key

Press to switch on the steam room, press again to switch it off. The steam room will shut down in 60 minutes automatically. (As picture1))

2).Steam key

Press The steam generator starts working. The temperature will be shown on the control panel like the picture 2.

3).Time adjusting

After the steam function is turned on, press will increase the setting time. When press the more than 1 second, the setting time will be increased continuously until you stop pressing. Or, just when it reaches the maximum limiting time(50 minutes) after that it will return to the minimum limiting time(5 minutes) automatically. Note: The time setting range is between 5-50 minutes. The default time setting is 30 minutes. (As picture3)

4).Temperature adjusting key

After steam function is turned on, press will increase the temperature. When press more than 1 second, the setting temperature will be increased continuously until you stop pressing Or, just when it reaches the maximum limiting temperature that it will return to the minimum limiting temperature automatically. Note: The temperature setting range is between 20 °C-50°C. The controlled temperature tolerance: ± 3°C The default temperature is 40°C.

5).Ventilator key


Press to turn on the ventilator , press again to turn off the ventilator.

6).Color light key

Press  to turn on the color light. After the color light is turned on, each more press will change the different colors of the light. The color light works in this sequence: Turn on, blue ---blue and red ---red----red and orange---orange ---orange and blue---blue---circulating---turn off.

7).lamp key

Press the  key to turn on the lamp, press  again and turn it off. (As picture 6)



8).Radio key

Press  to turn on the radio, press  again to turn off the radio.(As picture 7)

9).Channel memory key

Press  and release within 1 Second, the frequency of current channel will be changed; Press  and hold it more than 1 second, the frequency of current channel will be saved. It can hold a total memory of 8 channels



10).Select key

This Key has 2 functions. When the radio is turned on, This key shows the frequency function. Press the  key again and it will switch from the frequency function to the volume function. Press the  key, and the display will show like (pic 10) for frequency mode or (Pic 9) for volume mode.


11).Volume up key

After the radio is turned on(As Pic 9), Pressing  will increase the volume. If you hold the key for more than 1 second the volume will keep increasing until the key is released. When in frequency mode as in (Pic 10) pressing  will increase the frequency. Hold the key for more than 1 second and the frequency will keep increasing until the key is released.

12).Volume down key

After the radio is turned on(As Pic 9), Pressing  will decrease the volume. If you hold the key for more than 1 second the volume will keep decreasing until the key is released. When in frequency mode as in (Pic 10) pressing  will decrease the frequency. Hold the key for more than 1 second and the frequency will keep decreasing until the key is released.

Garbage

Our bins are along the East side of the building. You will see a number of bins.

Black Bin is for garbage
Blue Bins is for recycling
The Green Bin is for compost

Our garbage pickup is Wednesday night. We will have someone bring the bins to the sidewalk and bring them back the next day, but

if you have more than will fit in your bins, please keep it inside (or in the garage until garbage night and put it out yourself).

Cardboard can be tied or taped together or set out in a blue recycling bag, but garbage must be placed in a black bag and have a city of Toronto Garbage Tag (yellow sticker). We have stickers for your use in the garage (left side cabinet). Any garbage bags left out without a tag will not be collected.

Compost is put out weekly, but the garbage and recycling bins alternate weekly

Additional Parking

You are welcome to park in our garage. Do not park in the driveway, it is shared and we do not want to block our neighbours.

Most of the nearby residential streets allow 1 hour of parking during the day. Please keep an eye on the signs.

Parking Permit

A Temporary Parking Permit will allow you to park on the nearby residential streets anytime (Shanly St, Dovercourt Rd, Westmoreland Ave).

- Please keep an eye on the parking signs to make sure you are parking in properly designated areas
- Make sure you print the pass (we have a printer for your use and put the pass in your car windshield)

The Fees are:

24 hour - \$18.99 + HST

48 hour - \$27.45 + HST

7 days - \$41.16 + HST

Your pass is valid for Parking Area 3G (see the map on the next page)
